ATTENDANCE

All athletes must dedicate and make proper arrangements to attend all team meetings, practices, and scrimmages. Athletes that do not comply with missing <u>no more than three</u> scheduled practices, meetings, or scrimmages may be dismissed from scrimmages for team participation entirely.

GRADES

All athletes must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA in order to participate. Coaches may keep track of the athlete's progress in class, and may require the athlete to attend the afterschool program's homework hall if needed. If student player falls below 2.5 GPA while on the team, possible consequences include dismissal from the team entirely, or dismissal from scrimmage participation.

UNIFORM

All athletes are required to attend practice fully prepared with proper sports clothing. Sneakers, shorts, and short-sleeved shirts are required to participate in practice and scrimmages. The coaches will provide each team member with a uniform jersey, which the athlete is fully responsible for any damage or loss of their assigned jersey.

FEES

At the beginning of the season, each athlete must provide a non-refundable fee of \$20.00 (\$10.00 for students enrolled in the afterschool program). This will cover athlete's jerseys, equipment, water bottles, snacks, and season-end awards. Additional fees may be required if the athlete does not return his or her assigned jersey.

BEHAVIOR

All those involved and participating are expected to display and practice respect, good sportsmanship, and support to all coaches, team members, referees, and especially to our competing schools. Any display of disrespect or poor sportsmanship may result in scrimmage sit-outs or dismissal of team participation entirely.

STUDENT CONDUCT

As members of athletic teams, students are high-profile representatives of their school. Students are expected to always act in an appropriate manner. The following behavior is inappropriate at all times and will not be tolerated:

- 1. Fighting
- 2. Profanity
- 3. Possession of, use of, or being under influence of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs
- 4. Unsportsmanlike conduct
 - a. Any act of unsportsmanlike or inappropriate conduct will be dealt with swiftly.
 - b. If the act occurs during an athletic contest, the student will be removed from the contest.
 - c. A student who strikes, curses or threatens an official, coach, or opponent during a scrimmage or at any other time because of resentment over occurrences or decisions, or who fails to maintain a standard of conduct satisfactory to the school administration, may be deemed ineligible to participate in interscholastic athletics.
 - d. A student who is ejected from a contest for a flagrant foul or unsportsmanlike conduct may be prohibited from participating in any contest for a minimum of one week, or if no contests are scheduled during that week, the next contest.
- 5. Rude or disrespectful behavior toward any person (i.e. teacher, parent, coach, official)
- 6. Taunting opponents or official.
